Complementary Statistics Course Requirement:

Students must register for one of two statistics courses, either EDPE 682 (quantitative) or EDPE 687 (qualitative), depending on their proposed research. Students should consult with their research supervisor for more information about making this important decision.

While Thesis courses do not have scheduled class time, but rather represent progress on one's thesis in consultation with their supervisor, students must register for Thesis courses throughout their degree.

To complete degree requirements, student should have registered and completed Thesis 1 through 6.
