This would replace one of your complementary course options, in most cases.

1) **Field work** 3-credit option (EDPI 539) or Field work year-long option (EDPI 656D1/D2;6-credit option) Students must register for two CRN#'s Field Course and Seminar. This course provides the opportunity to expand your experiences working with students with diverse needs in inclusive, integrated, and segregated settings. Sites are selected that correspond to student needs, interests, and professional growth.
