

# Advising Handbook for Returning Students

## B.Ed. Physical and Health Education

*Fall 2018 and Winter 2019 Registration for Returning Students begins on the following dates:*

Wednesday, April 4 – Registration opens for **U3/U4** returning undergraduate students.  
Thursday, April 5 – Registration opens for **U2** returning undergraduate students.  
Friday, April 6 – Registration opens for **U1/all other** undergraduate students.

***It is crucial that students register in both the Fall 2018 and Winter 2019 terms.***

**\*NOTE: English Exam for Teacher Certification (EETC)**

All students newly admitted into Year 1 of the BEd program are required to write the English Exam for Teacher Certification during the fall term of their first year in the program. Students admitted with advanced standing must also write this examination in the fall term. The exam is coordinated by an independent body, the Centre for the English Exam for Teacher Certification. Students must register with the Centre [www.ceetc.ca](http://www.ceetc.ca) and pay a fee before writing the test.

McGill assists in administering the test. To schedule this examination, students must use Minerva to register for EDEC 215 in the Fall term. Students should ensure that the time selected for the test does not conflict with their course schedule.
