Procedures

- 1. Any U2 and U3 Kinesiology student interested in research may take this Practicum. A written statement of expectations, including such factors as time commitment in a lab, duties, tasks to be learned, and format of final project, will be signed by both professor and student prior to the start of the student's third year. (See Application for Research Practicum: EDKP 453)
- 2. The student is responsible for securing placement with a research supervisor. The student can ask advice from the DKPE Student Adviser.
- 3. The student must secure supervision from a faculty member before applying to register (see Application Form)
- 4. An Application Form signed by the student and the supervisor must be submitted to the DKPE Student Adviser and approved by the Undergraduate Program Director before the student can register and begin the Practicum.
- 5. Once a Research Supervisor has been secured, students may come see their advisor who will ensure registration permission for EDKP 453 via Minerva.

Research Practicum in Kinesiology Course Outline: EDKP 453

Focus

The intent of EDKP 453 is to engage students in a supervised kinesiology research setting.

Objectives

- 1. Obtain research experience in a program of kinesiology.
- 2. Develop competence in the management of data collection, technical abilities and an appreciation for the scientific method of conducting research.

Course requirements

1. A minimum of 75 contact hours in one semester.
