



## Chantal Malard Memorial Prize

### Description:

Established in 1997 by the Education Undergraduate Society in memory of Chantal Malard, a former Education student. Awarded to a student who has demonstrated artistic ability, leadership\* qualities, and involvement in volunteer activities while maintaining a high academic standing (e.g. at least 3.50 CGPA).

In your Personal Statement, outline your eligibility for the award, based on the following evaluation criteria:

- How have you demonstrated artistic/creative abilities in the past year?
- How have you demonstrated exceptional leadership skills in the past year?
- How do you volunteer/participate in your community in the past year?

\*Leadership is defined as: contributing towards "a relational process of people together attempting to accomplish change or make a difference"<sup>1</sup>.

### Eligibility Criteria:

- Undergraduate student in the Faculty of Education
- High academic standing (CGPA of at least 3.5)
- Must be graduating at the end of the current academic year (Spring convocation)
- Letter of reference is required. Should attest to experiences and abilities that are relevant to award terms.
