Description:

Established in 1999 by the Colwyn and Jean Rich Foundation in honour of James A. Robb, Q.C., B.C.L. 1954, graduate and friend of McGill University. Awarded on the basis of high academic achievement to a student who has completed at least one year of full-time study in the B.Ed. Secondary program. Preference will be given to students who have demonstrated leadership*.

In your Personal Statement, outline your eligibility for the award, based on the following criteria:

- Your academic achievements at McGill in the past year
- Your demonstrated leadership skills in the past year (e.g. volunteerism, extracurricular activities, athletics, etc.)

*Leadership is defined as: contributing towards "a relational process of people together attempting to accomplish change or make a difference"¹.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Completed at least one year of full-time study in the B.Ed. Secondary program at the time of application
- High academic achievement
- Preference for students who demonstrate leadership
