



Walter A. & K. Mary Marsh Scholarships in the Faculty of Education

Description:

Established in 2009 by K. Mary Marsh in memory of her husband, Walter A. Marsh, for outstanding undergraduate students in the Faculty of Education who have completed at least one year of the B.Ed. program (i.e. by the end of the current year) and who have demonstrated leadership* qualities.

In your Personal Statement, outline your eligibility for the award, based on the following criteria:

- One (or more) succinct example(s) of how you have demonstrated leadership in your student teaching, or in a McGill course project, or as a volunteer related to education and youth, or as part of an extracurricular activity related to education and youth in the past year
- Your plans for the coming year and how they reflect leadership

*Leadership is defined as: contributing towards "a relational process of people together attempting to accomplish change or make a difference"¹.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Undergraduate student in a Bachelor of Education program
- Must have completed at least one year in the program at the time of application
- Demonstration of leadership qualities
