

2014-2015 Highlights – McGill Engineering Career Centre

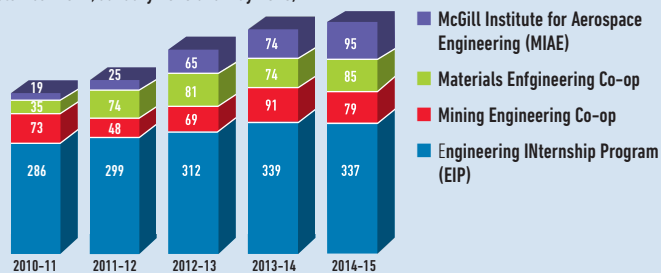
INTERNSHIPS AND COOPS

In the 2014-15 academic year, 596 engineering students participated in either internships or co-op work terms through the Engineering Internship Program (EIP), the Mining and Materials Co-op programs and the McGill Institute for Aerospace Engineering (MIAE).

- The number of employers hiring interns (Engineering Internship Program only) increased by 12% over last year.
- 49% of engineering students graduated with at least one 4-month internship or coop this academic year.

RECRUITMENT OUTCOMES AT TIME OF GRADUATION

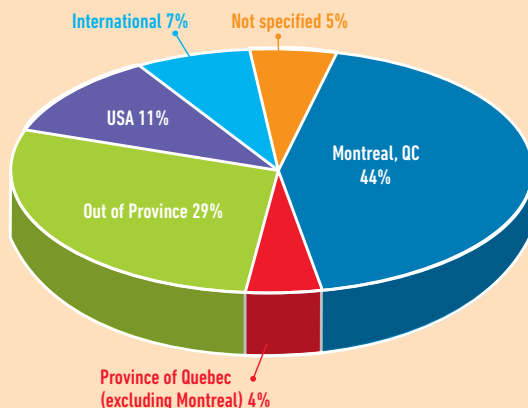
The results from the 2014-2015 B.Eng. graduating class survey* showed that, at time of graduation:

- 49% students found employment, 20% were pursuing their education, 2% postponed their job search and 29% were seeking work.
- Top 10 employers: Schlumberger, Microsoft, Bell Canada, Shell Canada, Cisco, Amazon, Bombardier Aerospace, Ciena, CITI and Ericsson.

INDUSTRY RECRUITMENT ON CAMPUS

The Engineering Career Centre, in conjunction with engineering and computer science students, organized the fully booked McGill Engineering & Technology Career Fairs, a 2-day event in Fall 2014 and a 1-day event in Winter 2015.

CAREER EDUCATION, NETWORKING & PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

In 2014-2015, the Engineering Career Centre hosted a broad range of career development workshops, company information sessions, speaker series as well as networking and mentoring events.

- **Professional guidance and coaching:** 1633 students attended 54 workshops and events and 1791 students received individual advising, including mock interviews with recruiters from industry.
- 1129 students and 124 professionals attended **36 Speaker and Networking Events**, co-hosted with student clubs, industrial partners and McGill Alumni.
