Applicants will be judged on academic achievement and a commitment to a career in the mining industry.

Application Requirements

Complete application packages must be submitted by April 30th and include:

- Letter of referral from a professor
- Essay describing how you are preparing yourself for a career in the mining industry, (maximum 400 words)
- Resume
- An official, sealed copy of your current academic transcript
