Established In Honour of Professor Michael Païdoussis (BEng '58)

The Michael Païdoussis Education Enhancement Fund was established in 2015 by Karim Barbir (BEng '81) in honour of Professor Emeritus Michael Païdoussis (BEng '58) and was matched by the Trottier Family Foundation.



Professor Michael P. Païdoussis joined the Department of Mechanical Engineering of McGill University in 1967. In 1976, he was promoted to Full Professor, and served as Department Chair from 1977 to 1986.

Since 1960, Professor Païdoussis has worked on various aspects of fluid-structure interactions, flow-induced vibrations, aero- and hydro-elasticity, dynamics, nonlinear dynamics and chaos. Prof. Païdoussis has been active in various committees of the American Society of Mechanical Engineering and is the recipient of multiple distinctions and awards.

Following his retirement in 2000, Professor Païdoussis was appointed as a Thomas Workman Emeritus Professor of Mechanical Engineering. Since then, he has been publishing extensively and continuing to mentor graduate students.
