ELIGIBILITY

The recipient will be a Canadian citizen selected on the basis of eligibility and must be enrolled fulltime and currently completing their third year of an eligible undergraduate Canadian university program.

QUALIFICATIONS

Applicants will be judged on academic achievement and a commitment to a career in the mining or mineral industries.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

A complete application package must be submitted by **April 30**, and include:

- Application form
- Letter of support from a professor
- Essay describing how you are preparing yourself for a career in the mining or mineral industries (maximum 400 words)
- Resume
- An copy of your current academic transcript (can be unofficial)

DISTRIBUTION

The scholarship recipient will be announced in September and the **\$2,000 scholarship** will be awarded providing the candidate remains active and enrolled in their faculty's mining or mineral program.
