DIRECTOR'S NOTE

"The most merciful thing in the world, I think, is the inability of the human mind to correlate all its contents. We live on a placid island of ignorance in the midst of black seas of infinity."

--H.P. Lovecraft, "The Call of Cthulhu"

This macabre idea inspires Alistair McDowall's contemporary play Pomona. If we really understood the consequences of our actions and the effect we have on the world around us, would we be able to survive this knowledge? Like Lovecraft before him, McDowall suggests the truth might be too much for our minds to bear.

Pomona begins as a search for a missing person. This mystery takes us into a labyrinth full of enigmatic characters, all in various states of desperation, all struggling to survive some unknown and terrifying threat that lurks amongst them.

But nothing is what it seems here, and Pomona teases and taunts us with hints, clues and puzzles about character identity and the connection between events. The story unfolds backwards and in fragments, like a maze, demanding that we follow the characters down Pomona's dark rabbit hole with our eyes fully open, most of all when we might wish to keep them firmly closed.

Just keep telling yourself it's only a game ...
