

Part-time Research Assistant to Support the Clinical Epidemiology Working Group

Description: The epidemiology program director, Arijit Nandi, together with faculty members of the Department of Epidemiology, Biostatistics, and Occupational Health (EBOH) and the Division of Clinical Epidemiology, Data Science, and Informatics, is exploring the development of a MSc concentration in clinical epidemiology. The research assistant would help to support this working group by helping to: (1) conduct an environmental scan of leading North American clinical epidemiology training programs, as well as relevant internal programs and resources; (2) design and field a survey of prospective applicants to an EBOH-administered MSc concentration in clinical epidemiology, in order to assess demand and inform structure; and (3) conditional on the results of the scan and survey, synthesize results and prepare a proposal for a new concentration.

Requirements: Must be a currently enrolled MSc, MScPH, or PhD student with an interest in clinical epidemiology and excellent organizational skills. Fluency in English and French preferred.

Timing and location: The position will remain open until filled, but would ideally begin in July and continue through the end of the Summer with a commitment of roughly 10 hours/week over this period. Work hours will be flexible. Work will be conducted virtually.
