

**POSITION: Part Time Research Assistant, Neuroepidemiology Research Unit**

**POSITION SUMMARY:** An excellent opportunity for an MSc, MScPH or PhD candidate.

Under the supervision of the Principal Investigator, Dr. Christina Wolfson, the successful candidate will participate in the conduct of systematic reviews on (a) the methods of surveillance for, and (b) the global epidemiology of, a rare adult onset neurological disorder. This part time position will be based at the Research Institute of the McGill University Health Centre (**temporarily working remotely**).

**RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Assisting in the literature searches for the two systematic reviews
- Second independent reviewer of articles selected for inclusion
- Assisting in the preparation of the reports

**REQUIREMENTS:**

- Strong methodological (epidemiological) knowledge
- Experience in systematic reviews would be an asset.
- Excellent organizational and communication skills
- Ability to multi-task and to work with minimal supervision
