Part-time "loads" for the 2011 and 2010 terms includes: part-time, Continuing Education, leave of absence, no credits, thesis half-time and unknown time status. The pre-200209 legacy term (pre-Banner) includes: part-time, Continuing Education, session of admission, thesis continuing, session of graduation, half-time, and leave of absence.

As of fall 2004, the non resident exchange students are reported under full-time "load".

These statistics are based on student's first and second departments within the primary and secondary curricula.

Departments are grouped within affiliated faculty, based on the Organization Unit table.

"Faculties of Arts and Science" includes students that are registered in both Arts and Science and are pursuing the B.A.&Sc. degree.
