What are your next steps?

1ST THESIS COMMITTEE MEETING (Year 1) September admissions: between March and June;

- January: between September and December
 Student presents thesis project and results
 obtained;
- Graduate Student's Research Progress Tracking Form and Minutes are completed by the Academic Advisor.
- ***Prior to the meeting, student should inform his Thesis Committee of his/her intention to fast-track.*** Guidelines on fast-tracking:

FAST-TRACK IS NOT RECOMMENDED

Student follows the timeline for the M.Sc.

THESIS COMMITTEE MEETINGS (Year 3 to ...)

- Student presents thesis project and results obtained;
 - Graduate Student's Research Progress
 Tracking Form and Minutes are completed by the Academic Advisor.

ACCEPTANCE INTO M.SC. PROGRAM (course credit requirements: 9 credits)

- Registration in July/August for September admissions.
 - Registration in November/December for January admissions

INITIAL MEETING WITH SUPERVISOR (Within 2 months of first registration)

- Research objectives and timelines are established;
 - Thesis committee members are determined;
- Letter of Understanding is completed.

FAST-TRACK IS RECOMMENDED

The recommendation must be clearly explained in the minutes and report of the first thesis committee meeting.

COMPREHENSIVE ORAL EXAMINATION

(Must be held in Ph.D. 2 year, within one year of the Thesis Committee meeting where the Fast-Track was approved by the committee)

- Student presents thesis project and results obtained;
 - Comprehensive knowledge is tested;
- Graduate Student's Research Progress Tracking Form and Minutes by the Academic Advisor.
