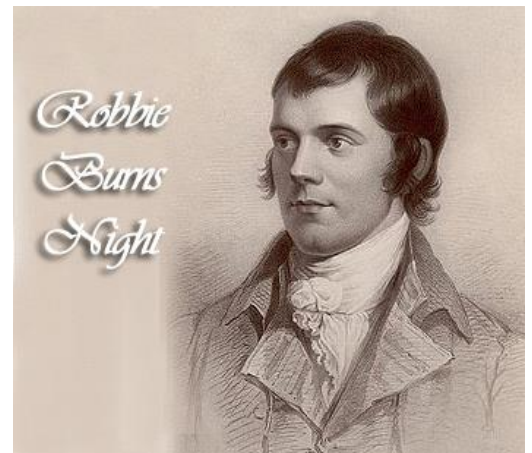
A minimum of 5\$ donation is required for admission with all proceeds going to Centraide.
