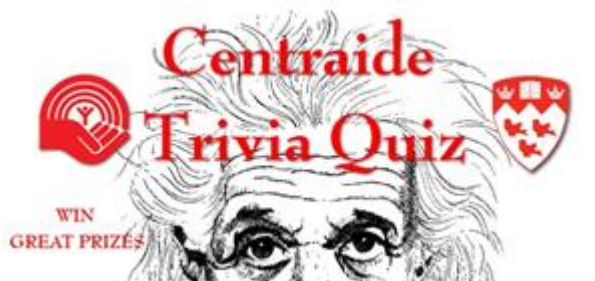


**Bridge: Tuesdays, January 9 and 23, 2018 -- Maude Abbott Room. 1:30 to 3:30 pm**

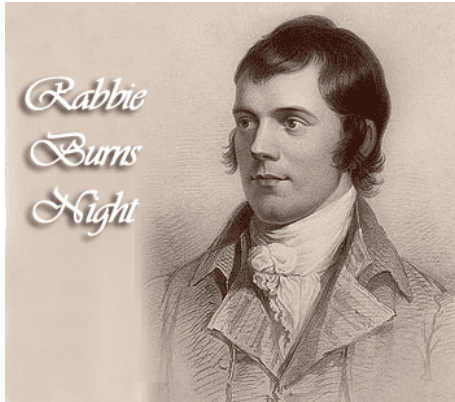
