Dr. Khanassov completed a Masters' thesis, the family medicine residency program and a fellowship in Care of the Elderly in the Department of Family Medicine at McGill. He was hired as an assistant professor in the department in July of 2017. As a student, he obtained FRQS bursaries and as a family medicine resident, he was nominated for McGill Medstar, for resident of the year, and he was the winner of the first "Patient's Choice Award" at the North American Primary Care Research Group conference. As a young staff physician, he won an FMOQ-FRQS Aspirant chercheur-boursier en médecine de famille (2017-2021) and an FRQS Clinician Researcher Junior 1 (2018-2022). His research is focused on the primary care for elderly people.

His research programs are funded by the CIHR, the FRQS, the Quebec Reseau-1 and the College of Family Physicians of Canada. He works as a family physician at the Herzl Family medicine practice, the Geriatrics department of the Jewish General hospital as well as the Institut universitaire de gériatrie de Montréal. He supervises the residents in family medicine, the fellows in Care of the Elderly of McGill and the Université de Montréal as well as the graduate students of the department. He also serves as a chair of the competency committee in the Care of the Elderly fellowship program of McGill. He is an active member of the Members Interest Groups Section (MIGS)/Care of the Elderly section of the College of Family Physicians of Canada.
