


## Performance Benchmarks According to Level of Training



COMMUNICATOR	<ul> <li>Able to set agenda with patient</li> <li>Adapts interview to clinical situation (location, acuity of situation, use of interpreter, etc.)</li> <li>Recognizes and responds to patient cues</li> <li>Uses open and closed-ended questions appropriately</li> <li>Consistently demonstrates empathy and active listening</li> <li>Allows time for appropriate silences</li> <li>Checks with patient to ensure understanding</li> <li>Provides information in a way the patient understands</li> <li>Adjusts communication style as needed (age, education, cognitive abilities, hearing loss, etc)</li> <li>Communicates with families where appropriate</li> <li>Able to handle complex or challenging patient interactions with sensitivity and skill</li> <li>Maintains an appropriate attitude in response to inappropriate/offensive language or comments made by the patient</li> <li>Able to convey benefits, risks and uncertainty</li> <li>Charting is accurate, focused and organized</li> <li>Written communication is accurate, organized and to the point</li> </ul>
PROFESSIONAL	<ul> <li>Arrives on time and appropriately dressed for clinical situation</li> <li>Follows up laboratory and other results, responds to messages, and completes letters and other documents in a timely manner.</li> <li>Completes charts in a timely manner; charting is accurate, focused and organized</li> <li>Notifies appropriately in event of absence because of illness or emergency</li> <li>Arranges coverage for practice when away and communicates appropriately when signing over responsibilities</li> <li>Aware of own limitations and asks for help when needed, but does not avoid challenging clinical situations</li> <li>Accepts feedback as constructive and a springboard for further learning</li> <li>Reflects on gaps in his/her medical knowledge and professional practice; if there is a critical incident, the resident is forthcoming and demonstrates self-reflection</li> <li>Shows respect for colleagues, staff, other team members and patients</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Is honest</li> <li>Aware of and respects confidentiality of patients and colleagues</li> <li>Aware of and respects boundaries of the professional role including applicable Codes of Conduct</li> </ul>
COLLABORATOR	<ul> <li>Demonstrates an understanding and respect for the roles of each member of the team</li> <li>Works well in a multidisciplinary environment demonstrating cooperation and respectful communication</li> <li>Considers when referrals are appropriate. Shows a good balance between autonomy and referral</li> <li>Consultation requests include clear reasons for consultation and an effective summary of all relevant clinical information</li> <li>Facilitates handover of care with appropriate information to ensure continuity and patient safety</li> <li>Prepares clear summary notes to assist in effective practice handover at end of residency</li> </ul>
HEALTH ADVOCATE	<ul> <li>Consistently takes a patient's social history.</li> <li>Recognizes impact of determinants of health and adapts treatment to the social and personal factors that influence compliance and health outcomes</li> <li>Regularly and appropriately uses the resources in their FMU setting for the benefit of their patients Supports patient and families in accessing community resources and navigating the health care system</li> <li>Consistently applies preventive health screening and health promotion guidelines for both adults and children. Recognizes when the screening guidelines for average risk patients does not apply to their patient.</li> <li>Takes opportunities to incorporate health promotion in patient encounters</li> </ul>
SCHOLAR	<ul> <li>Identifies own learning needs and creates a learning plan</li> <li>Identifies knowledge gaps that arise in clinical encounters and able to frame clinical questions that will facilitate search for answers in the medical literature</li> <li>Knows how to access the peer reviewed literature; able to assess a journal article critically</li> <li>Integrates best available evidence into practice</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Aware of limitations in applying evidence from clinical trials to individual patients; able to use evidence in clinical decision making along with the patient's values and preferences</li> <li>Actively participates in their site's scholarly activities</li> <li>Demonstrates ability to teach junior learners</li> </ul>
LEADER	<ul> <li>Able to see 6 - 8 patients per half day with minimal delays</li> <li>Demonstrates flexibility and adapts their schedule to match the needs of their patients when necessary; promotes continuity of care</li> <li>Plans appropriate follow-up of patients</li> <li>Provides comprehensive care</li> <li>Considers effective use of health care resources when planning investigations and treatment</li> <li>Understands basic principles of practice management and billing</li> <li>Able to follow and adapt strategy for maintaining personal wellness</li> <li>Considers the wellness needs of other team members</li> <li>Able to protect time for personal needs without compromising responsibilities</li> <li>Able to prioritize competing professional responsibilities</li> </ul>
