The COVID-19 Pandemic has altered the delivery of health care in Canada, including perinatal care. This seminar will present "lessons learned" about the delivery of high-quality perinatal care during the COVID-19 pandemic from two perspectives. Firstly, Dr. Kathleen ("Kate") Rice (Assistant Professor in the research division of the Faculty of Medicine, and Canada Research Chair in the Medical Anthropology of Primary Care) will present lessons learned from preliminary findings of her ongoing qualitative study of experiences of pregnancy and birth in Canada during the COVID-19 Pandemic.

Dr. Hannah Shenker (Assistant Professor in the Dept of Family Medicine and Program Director for the Enhanced skills Program in Maternal Child Health) will present her observations and lessons learned from the perspective of a family physician providing obstetrical care in Montreal.
