PERLE FELDMAN, MDCM, CCFP, FCFP, MHPE is an Associate Professor of Family Medicine at McGill University. She has returned to McGill after eight years at University of Toronto where she was the Post-Graduate Program Director for Family Medicine at North York General Hospital and an Associate Professor of Family Medicine, a member of the Curriculum Committee and a consultant to the Faculty Development Committee.

She has taught family medicine for over thirty years, currently teaching at CLSC Parc Extension. She was one of the founders of the maternal-child health fellowship in family medicine at McGill, and created the Goldfarb Breastfeeding Medicine clinic and training program. She was a member of the expert committee which created the 2001 Quebec government policy on Breastfeeding. She has recently served on both the national CanMeds 2015 Committee and CanMeds FM 2017 Committee. She served as a consultant in the creation of a national Family Medicine Curriculum for Brazil in 2014.

Her publications have appeared in Canadian Family Physician, CMAJ, and the American Journal of Ob/Gyn as well as being cited in William's Obstetrics. She writes short stories, some which have been published. She received her Master's degree in Health Professional Education from University of Illinois, Chicago.
