



#### **ACADEMIC HALF DAYS**

Our residents have "protected teaching time"/Academic Half Day teaching and learning activities each Wednesday afternoon. For the most part, these sessions are organized by the sites. The Priority Topics and the CanMEDS-FM roles (the CFPC evaluation objectives) are the main focus of these sessions. A suggested calendar in which the Priority Topics are covered between 41 weeks between the beginning of PGY-1 and the CFPC licensing exams. A suggested 42-week calendar is provided below.
