**Dr. Carol Herbert**

Dr. Carol Herbert is Professor Emerita of Family Medicine and Adjunct Research Professor in the Schulich School of Medicine & Dentistry at Western University (London, Canada) and Adjunct Professor in the Faculty of Education at U.B.C. (Vancouver). She is a Senior Associate at In-Source, a Vancouver-based consulting company that applies a complex adaptive systems lens to health care issues. She was formerly Dean at Schulich, Head of the UBC Department of Family Practice, founding Head of the Division of Behavioural Medicine, and a founder of the UBC Institute of Health Promotion Research. She was a founding Fellow of the Canadian Academy of Health Sciences, has chaired the CAHS Fellowship Committee and Standing Committee for Annual Meeting Planning, and is President (2015-2017). She is an International Member of the National Academy of Medicine of the U.S. National Academies of Sciences, Engineering and Medicine (formerly Institute of Medicine). She is Chair of the FMEC-PG Committee on Governance.
