### Dr. Howard Bergman

Dr. Bergman’s work in health services research and policy has focused on aging, chronic disease and frailty and on the promotion of primary care in general and primary medical care in particular. Dr. Bergman is a co founder and (former) co-Director of Solidage, he was one of 2 principal investigators in the development and evaluation of a randomized controlled trial - the SIPA model of integrated care for the frail elderly population. His work on integrated care for very frail older persons is recognized internationally in both academic, policy and government circles. Dr. Bergman led a group of Canadian and international investigators in the Canadian Initiative on Frailty and Ageing and leads the International Database Inquiry on Frailty. He is internationally recognized for his research on integrated care, frailty and chronic disease with over 170 publications as well as numerous reports and book chapters.
