Dr. Justin Jagosh is a Senior Research Fellow and Director of the Centre for the Advancement of Realist Evaluation and Synthesis (CARES) at the University of Liverpool. He is a co-investigator on the RAMESES II project to develop quality guidelines and reporting standards for Realist Evaluation. He facilitates introductory and intermediate-level workshops on realist methodology and has provided trainings and guidance for over 50 realist projects since 2013. Previously he was a CIHR postdoctoral fellow at McGill University (2009 - 2013), in which he co-led a comprehensive realist review examining the benefits of Participatory Research.
