Marie-Pascale Pomey is a physician and public health specialist. She is an associate professor in the Department of Management, Evaluation and Policy at the University of Montréal School of Public Health and a Research Associate at the University's of Montreal hospital centre (CRCUM). Her research focuses on the evaluation of quality and safety programs, and on the impact of accreditation systems on health institutions in terms of the dynamics of change and the implementation of continual quality and safety improvement programs and patient involvement at the different level of the health care system. She is Senior Scholar at the University of Montreal Hospital Center (CHUM) Evaluation Program of State-of-the-Art Technology and Methods covering Citizen and patient engagement in the transformation of health organisations and institutions (CRCHUM-FRQS-MSSS). She is also Co-Director of the Centre of Excellence on Partnership with Patients and the Public (CEPPP) and physician at l'Institut national d'excellence en santé where she is on charge of the CoMPAS+ program.
