4.0 Rationale and Admission Requirements for New Proposal

This graduate certificate is being created for nurses with a graduate degree in nursing and with pediatrics experience that would like to pursue studies to become a pediatric nurse practitioner in acute care pediatric hospital settings or specialized ambulatory/community clinics (2nd and 3rd line). Please note that one must complete the graduate diploma in Peds NP after completing the certificate in order to be eligible for practice in Quebec.

Admission Requirements: Applicants to the Graduate Certificate programs must hold a Master's degree in nursing that is equivalent to the one offered at the Ingram School of Nursing with a minimum of a 3.2 CGPA in their graduate degree. Applicants are also required to have a minimum of 2 years of clinical experience (3360 hours in the last 5 years) in pediatrics; full licensure from the OIQ; working knowledge of the French language and a successful selection interview.

The Graduate Certificate in Theory in Pediatrics prepares students to acquire the theoretical knowledge required to subsequently complete clinical courses in the Graduate Diploma in Pediatrics. This program is designed for students who previously completed a master's degree in nursing (equivalent to the McGill M.Sc.(A) in nursing program) but have not completed any nurse practitioner theory or clinical courses. Students will need to complete 6-12 credits in preparatory theory courses prior to entry into the Graduate Certificate program (the specific number of preparatory courses required will depend on whether some of the required courses were completed in their master's degree). Students should consult with the program Academic Adviser prior to applying.


