Admission Requirements:
Applicants are required to have a minimum of 2 years of clinical experience (3360 hours in the last 5 years) in pediatrics; a minimum of a 3.2 CGPA in their undergraduate nursing studies; full licensure from the OIIQ; working knowledge of the French language and a successful selection interview.




