Section A: Minor / Moderate Graduate Program Revisions

Faculty of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences:

M.Sc.A. in Biotechnology (Non-Thesis) (45 credits)

Added course HGEN 660 – Genetics and Bioethics (3 credits) to required courses. This increased the number of required course credits to 20 from 17 and decreased the number of complementary course credits to 9 from 12.

Faculty of Education:

M.A. in Second Language Education (Non-Thesis) (45 credits)

Moved required course EDEM 690 – Research Methods: Theory and Practice (3 credits) to the complementary course listing. Moved course EDSL 627 – Classroom-Centred Second Language Research (3 credits) from complementary course listing to required courses and changed course title to Instructed Second Language Acquisition (ISLA) (3 credits). Made the following changes to complementary course listing section: added new course [EDSL 640 – Language Awareness: Theory and Practice (3 credits)] and two existing courses [EDSL 601 – Methods and Curriculum in Second Language Teaching 1 (3 credits) and EDSL 602 – Methods and Curriculum in Second Language Teaching 2 (3 credits)]. Revised title of complementary course EDSL 620 – Critical Issues in Second Language Education (3 credits) to Social Justice Issues in Second Language Education (3 credits). Also, removed courses [EDSL 603 - Individual Reading Course 1 (6 credits) and EDSL 616 - Individual Reading Course 2 (3 credits)].

M.A. in Second Language Education (Thesis) (45 credits)

Moved course EDSL 627 – Classroom-Centred Second Language Research (3 credits) from complementary course listing to required courses and changed course title to Instructed Second Language Acquisition (ISLA) (3 credits). This increases required course credits to 12 from 9. Made the following changes to complementary course listing section: added new course [EDSL 640 – Language Awareness: Theory and Practice (3 credits)]. Revised title of course EDSL 620 – Critical Issues in Second Language Education (3 credits) to Social Justice Issues in Second Language Education (3 credits). Also, removed courses [EDSL 603 - Individual Reading Course 1 (6 credits) and EDSL 616 - Individual Reading Course 2 (3 credits)].

M.A. in Second Language Education (Thesis) Gender and Women's Studies (45 credits)

Moved course EDSL 627 – Classroom-Centred Second Language Research (3 credits) from complementary course listing to required courses and changed course title to Instructed Second Language Acquisition (ISLA) (3 credits). This increases required course credits to 15 from 12. Made the following changes to complementary course listing section: added new course [EDSL 640 – Language Awareness: Theory and Practice (3 credits)]. Revised title of course EDSL 620 – Critical Issues in Second Language Education (3 credits) to Social Justice Issues in Second Language Education (3 credits)]. This decreases the complementary course credits to 6 from 9.

Faculty of Law:

Master of Laws (LL.M.) in European Studies (Non-Thesis) (47 credits)

Added two new required courses [LAWG 601 – Communication 1 (1 credit) and LAWG 602 – Communication 2 (1 credit)]. Revised credit weight from 4 credits to 3 credits for two courses [CMPL 610 – Legal Research Methodology (3 credits) and CMPL 641 – Theoretical Approaches to Law (3 credits)]. Also, removed course [CMPL 600 – Legal Traditions (3 credits)] from the complementary course listing.

Faculty of Medicine:

M.Sc.A. in Communication Sciences and Disorders (Non-Thesis): Speech-Language Pathology (82 credits) Added new course SCSD 688 – Genetics in the practice of Speech-Language Pathology (1 credits) to required courses. Increased the total number of required courses from 75 to 76.
