#### 5.0 Rationale for revised program (cont'd)


The increase in credits within the Graduate Certificate reflects the additional NNP-specific content added to the concentration's curriculum (replacing some of the 'common' MSc courses). Those entering the program already having completed an MSc must take all of the NNP-specific courses to meet the requirements of the program (i.e., to develop the competencies that correspond to the exit profile of an NNP). Via this proposal, the existing Graduate Certificate in Neonatology is being retired.
