4.0 Rationale and Admission Requirements for New Proposal

Admission requirements for this program are the same as requirements for the other MA in Education and Society Options. This revision is proposing a coursework option for our MA Ed & Society program. This coursework option is being created, in order to provide balance between all three of our MA program offerings. Currently, all 3 of our MA programs with thesis options and non-thesis project options (other two are MA in Second Language Education, and MA in Leadership), however, the MA Ed & Society program is the only one without a coursework option. In addition, as we are increasing the 'project' requirement from 6 to 12 credits in the MA in Education and Society Non-Thesis project option (see accompanying program revision), adding the coursework option will serve students who prefer more coursework in their program. Adding the coursework option will serve a wider range of students and create parity between our programs.


