## 1. MANDATE (APPROVED BY SENATE ON OCTOBER 24, 2001)

The Council of Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies reports to Senate through APC, and has a mandate to:

- develop, revise and approve the regulations, guidelines and policies on graduate and postdoctoral studies and so recommend to Senate following consultation with the relevant disciplinary faculties;
- participate in strategic planning for initiatives to promote and enhance graduate and postdoctoral studies;
- review and approve proposals for the creation of new graduate programs.

## 2. COMPOSITION (APPROVED BY APC ON NOVEMBER 16, 2017)

The composition of the CGPS was approved by Senate in October 2001, and was refined during the first years of implementation of the new administrative structure for GPS. Further amendments were subsequently approved by APC. The current composition is as follows:

- Dean of Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies (GPS) – Chair (voice but no vote)
- Associate Deans of Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies (GPS) (voice but no vote)
- Director of Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies (GPS) (voice but no vote)
- Three representatives from each of the Faculties of Arts, Medicine, and Science
- Two representatives from each of the Faculties of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences, Education and Engineering
- One representative from each of the Faculties of Dentistry, Law and Management
- A representative from the Schulich School of Music
- A representative from Libraries
- Vice-Principal (Research and Innovation), or delegate
- Director of Teaching and Learning Services (TLS), or delegate
- Secretary-General of the Post-Graduate Student's Society (PGSS), or delegate
- A Postdoctoral fellow
- A Graduate Student from the Faculties of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences, Engineering or Science
- A Graduate Student from the Faculties of Arts, Education or Management
- A Graduate Student from the Faculties of Dentistry or Medicine
- A Graduate Student from the Faculty of Law or the Schulich School of Music
- Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies (GPS) Academic Affairs Officer (voice but no vote)
- Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies (GPS) Academic Affairs Officer (voice but no vote)
- Secretary to the Subcommittee on Courses and Teaching Programs (SCTP) (voice but no vote)
- Committee Secretary

With the exception of the PGSS representatives, Council members shall normally serve a maximum of two consecutive three-year terms (September to May).

#### 4.5 Cotutelle (Joint Thesis Supervision) Agreements

A cotutelle is an agreement of joint supervision at the doctoral level between two cooperating institutions, a Ph.D. student and his/her co-supervisors. The goal of such an agreement is to enhance student training and experience, and to facilitate collaboration and cooperation between the partner institutions. These agreements give students the benefit of carrying out doctoral research at two different institutions under the guidance of two supervisors with a pre-existing or emerging collaboration.

#### 4.6 Joint and Dual Degree Programs

- Kyoto-McGill International Collaborative PhD Program in Genomic Medicine**

This Joint degree program started in 2018 in partnership with Kyoto University, an institution that is part of Japan’s “Top Global University Project”. Cohorts follow a common curriculum in Genomic Medicine approved by the Japanese government. At McGill, the students are based in the Human Genetics PhD program. McGill and Kyoto University jointly select and admit students. Students pursue their programs and spend consecutive terms at both institutions. In the end, they are awarded a joint PhD degree.

Currently, there are 9 students pursuing this Joint PhD degree.

- Dual Master’s in Public Health Data Science**

McGill University has partnered with Université de Bordeaux to offer a Dual Degree in Public Health Data Science (MSc). The program was approved for funding by the French government as part of “écoles universitaires de recherche” in October 2017, and the Agreement between the two institutions was signed in 2018. At McGill, it is administered by the Department of Epidemiology, Biostatistics, and Occupational Health. Bordeaux’s program focuses heavily on data science, while McGill’s program focuses on foundational courses in epidemiology, biostatistics, and public health. Both programs complement each other’s strengths.

Currently, there are 2 students pursuing the Dual Master’s degree. They are expected to graduate in Summer 2020.

- Dual Master’s Degree in Neuroscience and Biomedical Engineering**

The University of Electronic Science and Technology of China (UESTC) is a Class A “Double First-Class University” with strengths in engineering and computer science. The partnership with McGill (#1 in graduate neuroscience in Canada) offers a cooperative program of immersive and integrated international experience. The program is structured and cohort-based, with the teaching delivered in China and a research semester taken at McGill. At McGill, the students are registered in the Integrated Program in Neuroscience.

McGill is expecting a first cohort of students to register in Fall 2021.
