**Section A: Minor / Moderate Graduate Program Revisions**Faculty of Arts:**Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) in Anthropology (Thesis) (0 credits)**

Added two new courses (ANTH 701 PhD – Comprehensive Examination and ANTH 702 PhD – Proposal Defence) and moved two complementary courses (ANTH 602 – Theory 1 and ANTH 603 – Theory 2) to the required course listing. Increased the potential list of elective courses to 24 credits from 12 credits, since some students require foreign language training, which might entail several years of intensive courses.

**Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) in Anthropology (Thesis): Neotropical Environment (0 credits)**

Deletion of the list of complementary courses in the section “Required Courses – If admitted to Ph.D.1” in order to eliminate confusion and allow greater flexibility for students in course selection.
