Section A: Minor / Moderate Graduate Program RevisionsSchool of Continuing Studies**Graduate Certificate in Public Relations and Communications Management Practice (15 credits)**

Revised 30-credit diploma to two (2) 15-credit graduate certificates (this is first certificate). New courses; content update to address industry needs. Change in delivery format from in-person to online.

Graduate Certificate in Strategic Public Relations and Communications Management (15 credits)

Revised 30-credit diploma to two (2) 15-credit graduate certificates (this is second certificate). New courses; content update to address industry needs. Change in delivery format from in-person to online.

Graduate Diploma in Legal Translation (30 credits)

Changes to course credits to reflect student workload. Change from 500- to 600-level to reflect advanced nature of the material. Change of course titles to reflect course content.

Faculty of Education**Certificat d'études supérieures en pédagogie de l'immersion française (15 credits)**

Change in delivery format from in-person to online. New course offerings. 3-credit courses replaced with 1- and 2-credit courses.

M.A Second Language Education (Non Thesis) (45 credits)

Increased credit weight for complementary courses. Decreased credit weight for elective courses. Addition of complementary and elective course offerings. Revised program title and program description to reflect course-based nature of the option.

New mandatory course on qualitative methods specific to rehabilitation research (POTH 609). Addition of course offerings in advanced qualitative/mixed methods via courses already offered by other departments. Credit change for POTH 614.

M.Sc. Experimental Medicine; Digital Health Innovation (45 credits)

New complementary course (EXMD 630). Required course (EXSU 620) changed to complementary. Change in credits for required and complementary courses.

M.Sc. Applied, Occupational Therapy (63 credits)

Removal of POTH 614 from complementary course listing due to change in credit weighting and course content.
