Rationale for Program Changes to MA Counselling Psychology: Research Project

The proposed changes include increasing the credit weights of two courses (EDPC625, EDPC 626) from 3 to 6 credits each, and changing the research project (EDPC619, 620, 621) from 3 x 3 credit courses to 6 x 3 credit courses. The changes are proposed to reflect the level of work that students are required to do in both the clinical and the research domains of the MA non-thesis, (project concentration) in Counselling Psychology. Additionally, these changes address the previous compression of courses due to the prior change from a thesis to a non-thesis program.

In the research project courses, students are required to research a domain, pose a question based on that research, develop a method to answer the question, obtain ethics approval, collect and analyze the data, and write it up in a manuscript suitable for publication. Students are typically requiring a summer to work on the project over and above their work during the school year. Splitting this work into 6 different courses more accurately reflects the work that students are doing. It will also permit them to retain the funding from federal and provincial funding agencies. Currently they are required to give up their funding in the summer because although they are working on research, they are not registered in courses.

The weekly work load in the Clinic Practicum (EDPC 625, EDPC 626) involves a class (3 hours), a group supervision meeting (3 hours), 4 clients meetings per week (4 hours), review of DVDs of client sessions (4 hours), note taking and report writing (1-3 hours), as well as reading, research and session planning for each client (2-6 hours) for a total of 17-23 hours per week. Three credits per semester do not accurately reflect this work. Increasing the credit weight for these courses is also necessary for students to have the allowable credits to have full-time status through 5 semesters.
