Dean Kreiswirth welcomed Professor France Bouthillier and Professor Joan Bartlett from the Faculty of Education, School of Information Studies who presented the program revisions.

Professor Bouthillier presented the proposed title change for the Master of Library and Information Studies (M.L.I.S.) to “Master of Information Studies (M.I.S.)”. She explained the content changes and updates of the required courses and the transition from three areas of specialization to two Streams: Course-Based and Research Project. Professor Bouthillier also highlighted the benefits of updating these existing courses and adding new complementary ones.

i) Demonstration of version 2.0 of the online graduate admissions system (3:15)

Dean Kreiswirth welcomed Mr. Kostya Dykukha from the Project Management Office, Mr. Mark Quinsey from Graduate Admissions Project and Mr. Larry Verkade from Admissions and Recruitment who presented the uApply system.

Mr. Quinsey presented a demo of the Apply, Evaluate & Decision modules and provided details on the training available to new users. Mr. Verkade, Mr. Dykukha and the members of the committee discussed during Q & A period the potential to generate reports by accessing statistics and data from the system.

j) Update on Support for Supervision

Dean Kreiswirth discussed the Canadian Professional and Graduate Survey results, which aimed to gather student's views on supervision. He also described McGill's parallel survey targeting supervisors and supervisees, the results of which are undergoing analysis. This survey was designed in collaboration with the Post-Graduate Students' Society (PGSS) and the McGill Association of University Teachers (MAUT).

Mr. Mooney, Secretary-General of PGSS, pointed out that they wish to collaborate with the parties to create a FAQ document that clearly outlines guidelines and establishes broad practices that can be implemented at the Faculty level. In the meantime, any questions or concerns regarding this FAQ can be directed to Ms. Thurston.
