The changes: 1) clarify the function of the Graduate Diploma in Performance (originally Graduate Diploma in Professional Performance) as a polishing degree for refining technique and mastering repertoire; 2) provides a more flexible program addressing the needs of a broader range of students (graduates from B.Mus., Licentiate, and M.Mus.), thus allowing enrolment to increase at the graduate level.</p>

<p>New Description</p> <p>A one-year graduate performance diploma that allows excellent musicians to refine their technique and master repertoire through intensive coaching, practice, and performance projects. Designed as a polishing diploma, the program prepares musicians for professional careers as soloists, opera singers, collaborative pianists, chamber, jazz and orchestral musicians or for further graduate studies in performance. Flexible program requirements, with range of performance project options including solo, chamber, recording, orchestral auditions, and creative collaborations. Admission is by audition, with candidates having previously completed a B.Mus., a Licentiate, or M.Mus.</p> <p>Old Description:</p> <p>The Graduate Diploma in Professional Performance is open to accomplished professional musicians, singers, or established chamber ensembles wishing one year of in-depth studies to complete a specific project.</p>
