

PBEEE Eligibility Requirements *at-a-glance*

for use by Department Administrators when determining eligibility for screening phase

▶ Applicants are expected to have submitted the PBEEE Screening Form, Application, **AND** copies of **all** post- secondary transcripts to their academic unit by the posted deadline in order that units may assess and report eligibility based on the following:

- Applicant is **not** Canadian or Permanent Resident of Canada and **has not** applied for Permanent Residency. Applicant has indicated a foreign home address on the PBEEE Screening Form
- Applicant falls in one of the following categories:
 - Postdoctoral**. Applicant must have completed **all** requirements of the PhD by January **2022** at the latest; must **not** have completed PhD before November 1, **2018** (except in cases of documented interruption for parental leave); and PhD was **not** obtained at McGill.
 - Short-term - A**. Candidate has not yet completed a PhD, and **not** currently at McGill
 - Short-term - B**. Candidate has already completed a PhD after November **2015**, and **not** currently at McGill
- Minimum **overall** CGPA of 3.7 (Law 3.4). **Students with CGPA lower than 3.70 may be deemed ineligible.** Please show overall **postsecondary** CGPA as well as the division between Undergrad and Graduate GPA.

▶ Units are expected to complete FAD to screen all candidates who wish to be considered for this competition, using the information provided by the candidate PLUS the CGPA calculation.
