# Sustainable development versus outer space governance and sustainable development

- A change in how we approach overall management of the Earth's resources so as not to compromise the future of coming generations
- Ecology: understanding the consequences of all actions of development
- All stakeholders have a role to play in the present and future evolution of human activity
- State powers and the press and media try to achieve transparency and public awareness
- Press and media focus on questions related to sustainable development on Earth
- ... is there a focus in the press and media on sustainable development related to space governance?

# Frame of reference: The Fourth Estate and Strategic Intelligence

- A democratic state system :
   3 powers legislature, executive, judiciary
- The Fourth Estate: press and media = communication means playing an influential role in political, social and economic debate
- 21st century: explosion of voices, platforms and means of information production and dissemination
- Many projects need more visibility

- Strategic intelligence : a convergence between management, political science, information science
- Information watch, knowledge management, information protection and mechanisms of influence
- Information analysis
- If the works in this field are visible for the public... access to information? ... social acceptability?


# Publication intensity in the press and media of articles related to space governance

    - in the lead paragraph, in the title, subtitle, title heading, in text




### Graph 1. "sustainable development" in the press and media (LEAD, 1987-2017)
