## **Suggestions for dinner / evening of Friday, 9 May:**

### **I – Bairro Alto area**

A traditional area with narrow streets, bars and restaurants of all types and prices. Located on top of the hill within walking distance of Hotel Suíço Atlântico and Avenida Palace (10 min. by taxi); 10 to 15 min. by taxi from the venue of the cocktail and from Hotel Ibis.

### **II – The Docks – a new entertainment area on the riverside.**

1. *Doca de Santo Amaro*, Alcântara (15 min. by taxi from the cocktail venue)  
A row of restaurants (and bars), by the marina, most of which do not require a reservation.
2. *Doca de Santa Apolónia* (15 to 20 min. by taxi from the cocktail venue)
  - Bica do Sapato Restaurant – A fashionable restaurant with three different areas: (i) the coffee-shop, with reasonable prices and an outdoor area; (ii) the restaurant; (iii) the sushi bar.  
Reservation required: Tel. 21 881 0320
  - Casa Nova Restaurant – Good italian food, cheap, with an outdoor area, gets very crowded and does not accept reservations.
  - Discoteca Lux – Fashionable nightclube, next to Bica do Sapato Restaurant.

Note that Doca de Santo Amaro and Doca de Santa Apolónia are not near each other, the former is on the eastern part of Lisbon, and the latter on the west.
