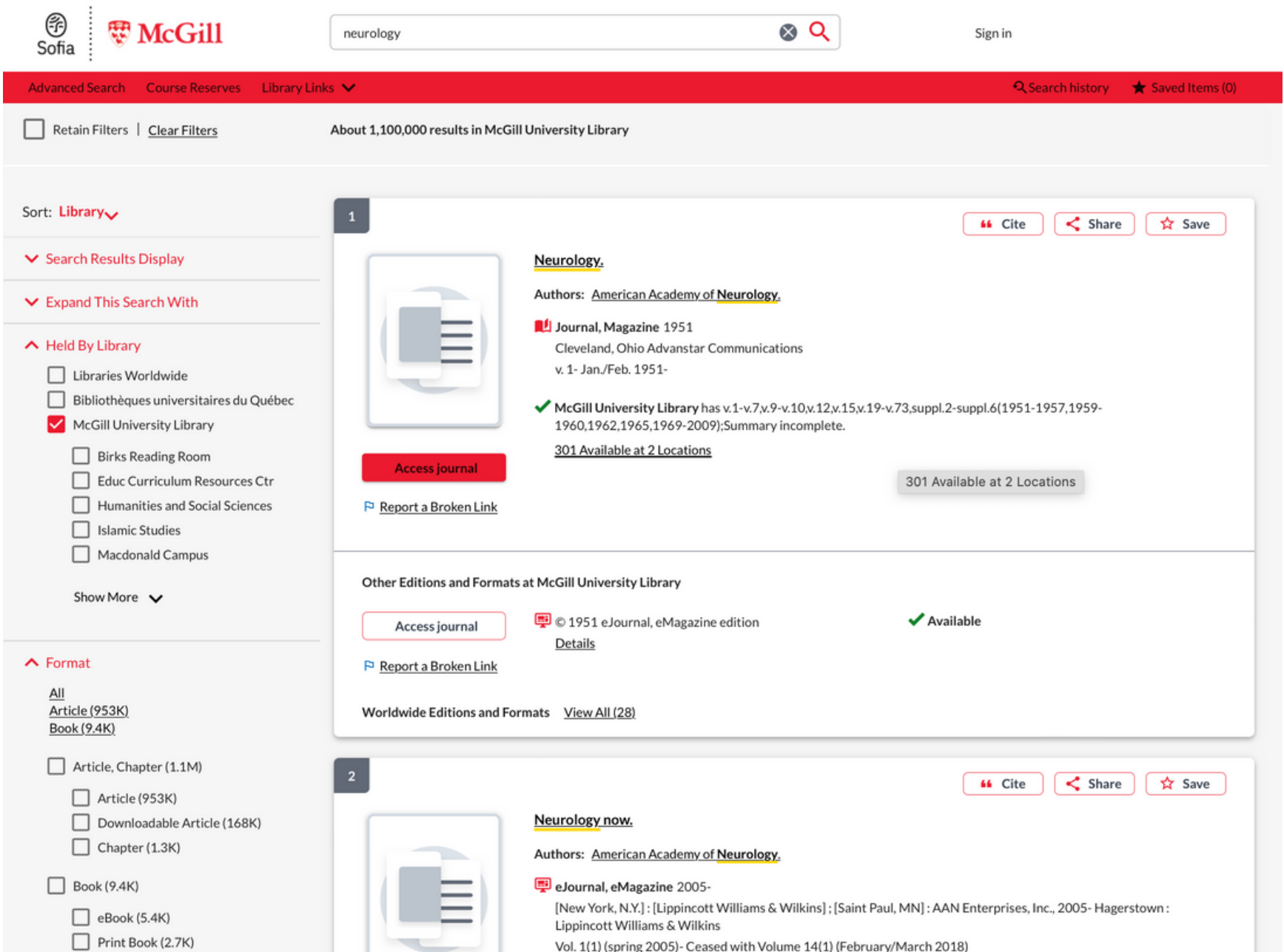
Searching WorldCat Discovery

WorldCat Discovery is the main catalogue for all books and other media available through the Neuro-Patient Resource Centre.

To find books and other media you can search WorldCat Discovery using the title, author, and/or any combination of keywords



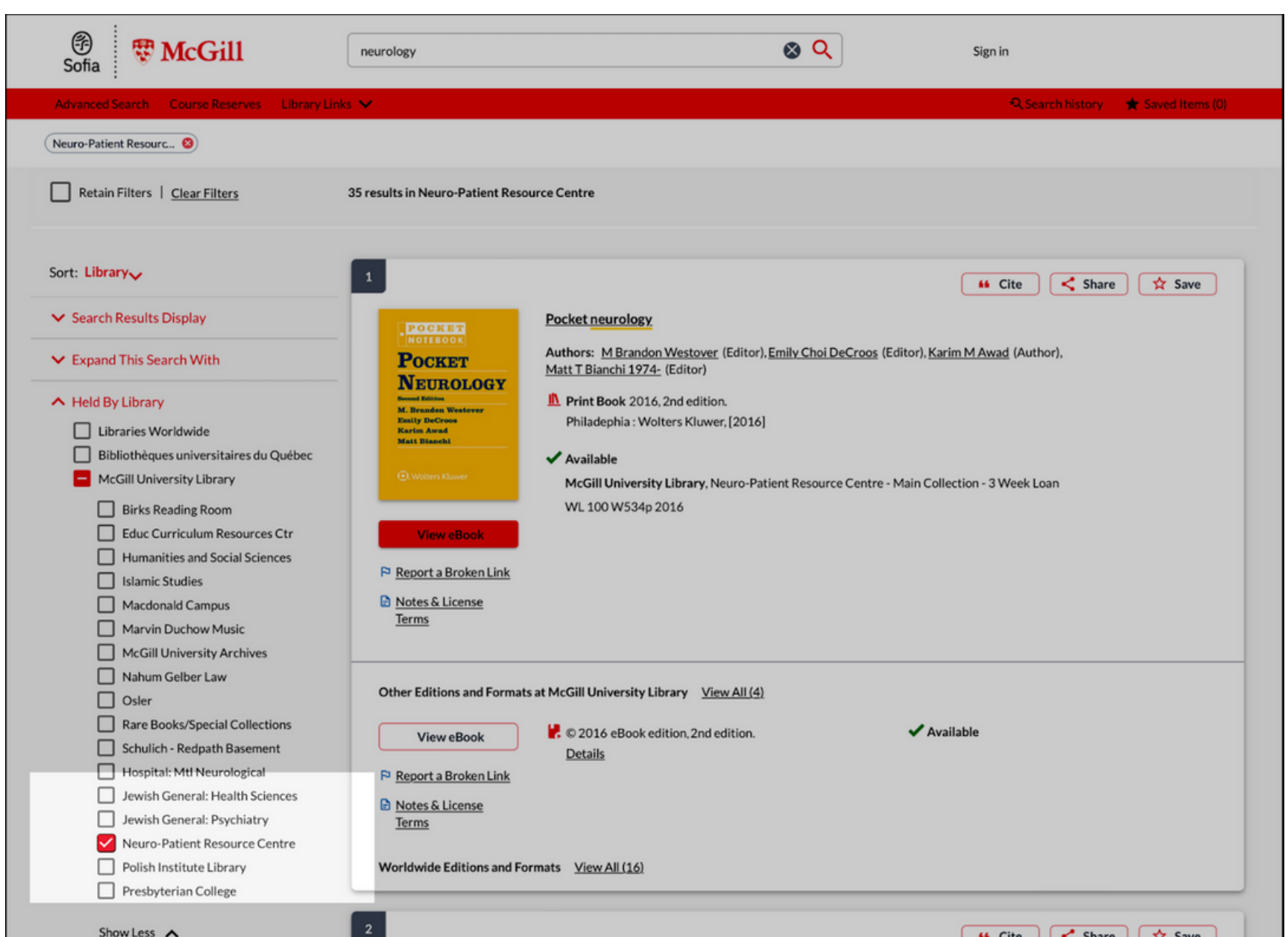
WorldCat Discovery will display your search results, along with several options to filter or sort them.



Tip: By default, WorldCat Discovery will treat your keywords as separate words. To search using a phrase, use double quotes. For example, "Multiple Sclerosis"

Narrowing your search scope to the Neuro-Patient Resource Centre's book collection

By default, WorldCat Discovery searches the whole McGill Library collection of resources. However, you can easily narrow your search to only include the collections of specific branches, such as the Neuro-Patient Resource Centre.
