- Request through [interlibrary loan](#) (free for you to use)



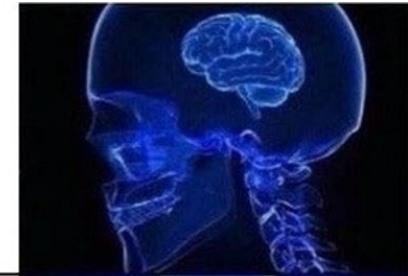
