

Graduate Research Enhancement and Travel (GREAT) IPN Travel Award

Thesis Master's or Doctoral students are eligible for a GREAT award if they are:

- In good standing,
- Registered full time, and
- NOT in time limitation.

Awards must be used to support virtual research travel and dissemination of research, including, but not limited to:

- Conference presentations (and equivalent dissemination activities in research-creation disciplines, such as Music);
- Field research; archival research; collaborative research outside the university.

Students must meet the eligibility criteria at the time of travel and will be granted after proof of registration.

Award Value: To be determined by our committee
