OVERVIEW:

The Ph.D. Thesis Seminar is a 45-minute public seminar in which the student presents their research. Students should present the background and rationale for their proposed studies, the specific hypotheses tested, and the results obtained to date. Following the student's seminar, the student's Advisory Committee will exclusively deliberate to determine whether the student has completed sufficient research to proceed with their thesis writing. The student's mentor is not obligated to attend the Ph.D. seminar presentations; the decision to allow the student to proceed with the writing of the thesis rests entirely with the Advisory Committee.

- 2) You may fill in the form's fields electronically, except for those pertaining to signatures.
- 3) Save the PDF. Print it out and bring it with you to your Thesis Seminar.
- 4) After your Ph.D. Thesis Seminar has taken place and your Advisory Committee has approved your research, all members must sign in the specified fields.
