CURRICULUM & ACCREDITATION

The Maple Leaf World School Program is a university preparation English language High School Program designed for international and domestic learners. The innovative curriculum emphasizes academic excellence through a diverse, dynamic, engaging learning curriculum that includes higher level thinking skills and inquiry-based learning resulting in students being prepared for success at reputable universities and as contributing global leaders and citizens. Students are taught in English by certified teachers. The school undergoes a rigorous annual inspection and is accredited by Cognia (formerly AdvancEd).
