A. 0-18 credits: Language

Each Honours student will complete at least one Jewish language at the advanced level of instruction. A student who can demonstrate competence in a Jewish language may be permitted to substitute other courses for all or part of the language requirement.

C. 27-45 credits

Complementary courses will be planned with an advisor and will normally be chosen to reflect progress to the advanced level in two of the following Areas of Study: Biblical Studies, Rabbinic Studies, Literature, Jewish Thought, Jewish History, Modern Jewish Studies and East European Studies. According to Faculty regulations, Honours students must maintain a minimum CGPA of 3.00 and a Program GPA of 3.0 or higher.

Courses related to Jewish Studies offered in other departments may qualify, but must be approved by the Undergraduate Program Advisor.

Students who wish to study at the Honours level in two Arts disciplines can combine Joint Honours program components from any two Arts disciplines; see <u>Joint Honours Programs</u> section in the undergraduate calendar for a list of available programs.

Joint Honours students should consult an adviser in each department to discuss their course selection and their interdisciplinary research project (if applicable).
