

Hebrew Placement

How do I know in which level to register?

JWST 220D1&2 Introductory Hebrew	6 or fewer years of Hebrew instruction in elementary school outside of Israel or equivalent*
JWST 320D1&2 Intermediate Hebrew	Completion of 220D1&2, or 7-8 years of Hebrew instruction in middle school outside of Israel, or completion of beginners 1 & 2 in CEGEP, or level Alef at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem, or levels 1 & 2 at Tel-Aviv University, or equivalent*
JWST 340D1&2 Advanced Hebrew	Completion of 200 (summer intensive course) or 320D1&2, or 9-11 years at Bialik or Maimonides high schools in Montreal, or new stream at CHAT high school in Toronto, or level Bet at the Hebrew University, or levels 3 & 4 at Tel-Aviv University, or equivalent*
JWST 367/368/369/370 Studies in Hebrew Lang. & Lit.	Completion of 340D1&2, or 9-11 years at Herzliah or at Hebrew Academy high schools in Montreal, or CHAT high school in Toronto, or Intermediate 1 or 2 in CEGEP, or level Gimel at the Hebrew University, or levels 5 & 6 at Tel-Aviv University, Maimonides and Tichon Chadash in Boston, Frisch Yeshiva High School and Ma'ayanot in New Jersey or equivalent*

Other considerations before placing yourself:

I.

- If you studied in Israel for at least 5 years of elementary school AND Hebrew is not your parents' first language AND you had no further Hebrew instructions outside of Israel, please register in **JWST 340D1&2 – Advanced Hebrew.**
- If you studied in Israel for at least 3 years of middle/high school AND Hebrew is not your parents' first language AND you had no further Hebrew instructions outside of Israel, please register in **JWST 367/368/369/370 Studies in Hebrew Lang. & Lit.**

II.

- If both parents speak Hebrew but you have NO knowledge of Hebrew reading and writing, please register in **JWST 340D1&2 – Advanced Hebrew.**
- If both parents speak Hebrew, and you have SOME knowledge of Hebrew reading and writing, please register in **JWST 367/368/369/370 Studies in Hebrew Lang. & Lit.**

* Students who are uncertain in which level of Hebrew they belong should consult Ms. L. Fima or Ms. K. Slouch for placement prior to registration.
