# ABOUT WARSAW UNIVERSITY LAW REVIEW

---

The Warsaw University Law Review (Przegląd Prawniczy Uniwersytetu Warszawskiego) is a student-led law journal founded in 2002. It is an independent nonprofit organization which produces a law journal edited and published by students of the Faculty of Law and Administration of the University of Warsaw.

The Warsaw University Law Review comes out twice a year encompassing about 20 papers in each number. The authors of the published papers come from a wide range of universities and include students, PhD candidates and professors.

Moreover, the Warsaw University Law Review cooperates with numerous and recognised law specialists who are engaged in a review process – the full list for each volume is available at our website.

# SUBMISSIONS

---

The Warsaw University Law Review welcomes submissions of articles, commentaries, book reviews and reports of important academic events. The Board of Editors invites pieces concerning various aspects of law. However, a priority will be given to the analysis containing an international or European legal dimension.

Prospective articles written in English should be sent to: [ppuw@wpia.uw.edu.pl](mailto:ppuw@wpia.uw.edu.pl) and should conform to a chosen and well-established style guide (e.g. Bluebook, OSCOLA).

All manuscripts should be submitted in Word (.doc or .docx) and should be between 4,000 and 10,000 words including footnotes.

Submissions are accepted on a rolling basis. However, submissions for the upcoming number should be sent no later than 31 January 2017. However, in individual cases the Board of Editors may slightly extend the deadline.

# PUBLISHING PROCEDURE

---

The submitted papers are subject to a first-tier (preliminary) review within the Board of Editors. At this stage wording, spelling and basic substantive matters are being verified.

Should the result of the first-tier review be positive, anonymised papers are sent to two anonymous specialists in the particular field of law (double-blind review process).

The paper must be recommended for publication by both reviewers in order to be published.

The process of review takes from 3 to 12 months.
