

Table of cumulative averages (CGPA) for undergraduate students

These tables below show the percentage of undergraduate students whose Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) falls within each grade range. It is based on information available at the end of each academic year. It is normally updated each June. *Individual student rankings are not compiled by the Faculty and the Faculty does not provide ranking letters of any kind.*

Dean's Honour List (DHL)

A maximum of the top 10% of students in the Faculty of Law are named to the Dean's Honour List at the end of each academic year. This is a non-monetary designation that appears on your official McGill transcript.

For non-graduating students, the DHL is determined on the combined GPA for the fall and winter terms only (Sessional GPA (SGPA)). The top 10% listed below (for both 1st years and upper years) DOES NOT reflect the final DHL SGPA. Students must have completed at least 27 graded credits (minus S/U Option) to be considered eligible for the DHL. *The DHL for in progress students for 2017-2018 was a SGPA of 3.38.*

For graduating students, the DHL is determined on the Cumulative Average (CGPA) of the entire B.C.L., LL.B. Program. ,
